## SPONSORED RIDE SATURDAY 19<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2008

### RIDE RULES

1. No claims will be entertained for anything which may happen to Competitors, their servants, spectators, horses, vehicles or property in connection with or arising from this event, and it shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the Organisers and Berkshire College of Agriculture against any legal action arising from any mishap.
2. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
3. Riders must wear suitable riding attire for this type of event which **MUST** include a correctly fitted Hard Hat with three point fastening secured and complying with BSI Standards PAS015, BSEN1384 or ASTM F1163 and proper riding footwear.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry and withdraw or amend any prizes offered at their discretion.
5. No entry fees will be refunded.
6. Competitors are requested to ride sensibly on this Sponsored Ride at all times.
7. We recommend that Mobile Phones are carried by all riders and that they take a Mobile Number of the Ride Organisers / Secretary before they set off on the Ride.
8. The ride will be way-marked by staff at BCA
